The National bicycle ride will start at 8.30am tomorrow, where riders will leave from the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Capital Projects in Floriana.

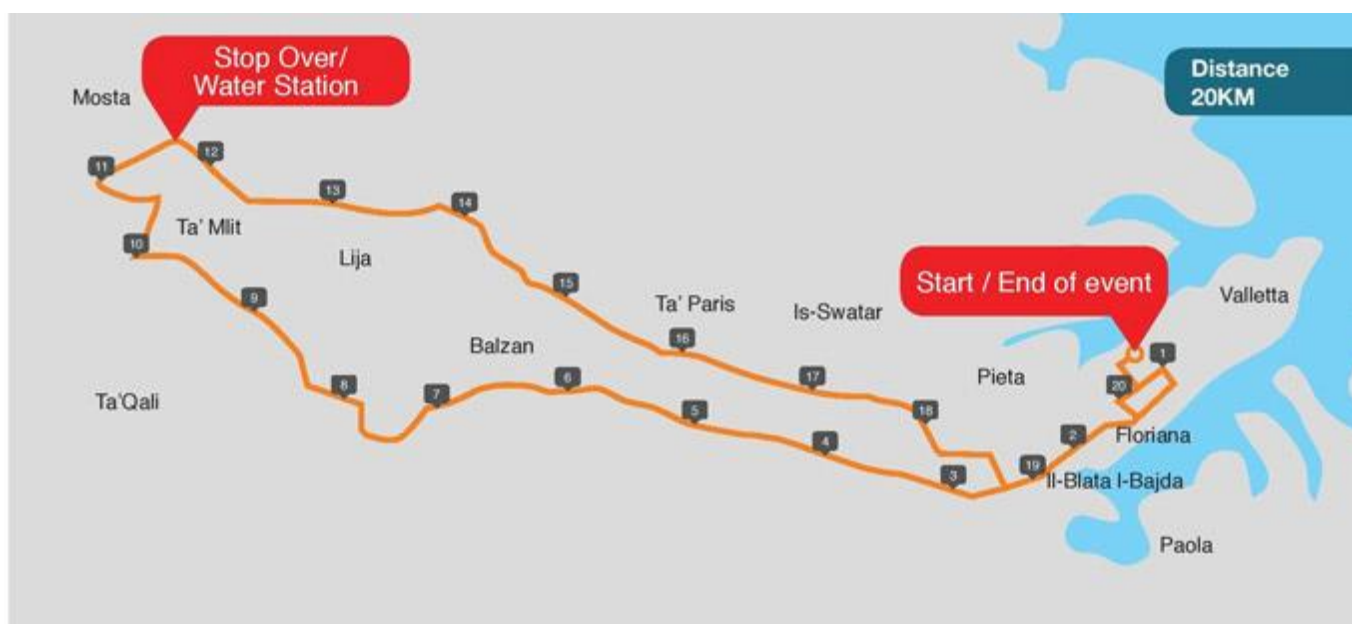
The riders will cycle through Blata l-Bajda, Ħamrun, St. Venera, Attard and Mosta, where they will head back through Lija, Birkirkara, St. Venera and Ħamrun until they reach the Ministry. The ride is expected to last around 100km.
