National bike ride tomorrow



A national bicycle ride is being held tomorrow from 8.30am.

Riders will meet at the Transport Ministry in Floriana and cycle through Blata I-Ba, Sta Venera, Attard and Mosta, from where they will head back through Lija, Birkir Venera and Hamrun until they reach the ministry. The ride is expected to last a few hours. A number of Transport Malta's electric vehicles will accompany the riders on the trip to ensure safety.

Anyone with a bicycle can attend. Registration is free of charge and starts at 8am at the ministry. Every participant will get a free t-shirt and five lucky ones will win a prize worth around €1,400.

This is the 4th edition of the national bicycle ride. It is one of the initiatives being organised by the Malta National Electromobility Platform which Transport Malta is organising for European Mobility Week.

The theme for this year's edition is "Sharing gets you Further".
